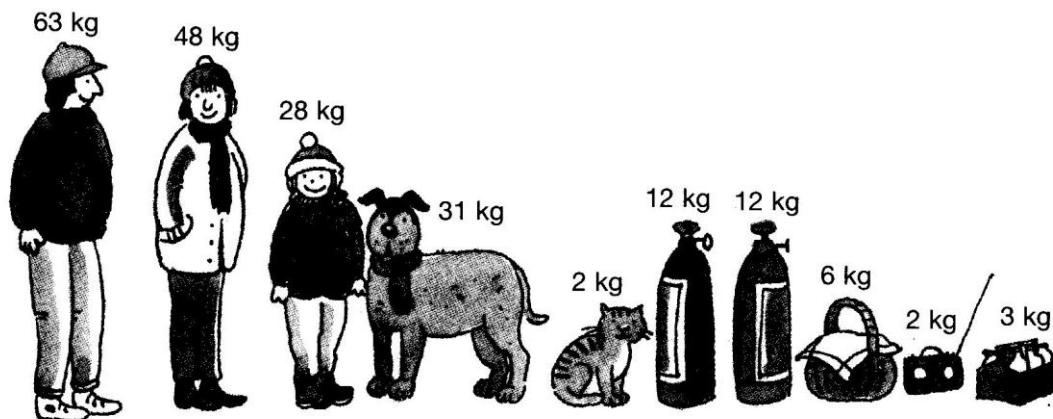
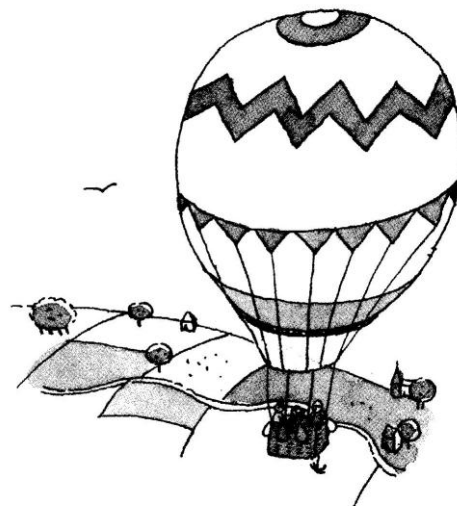

Balloon Trip!

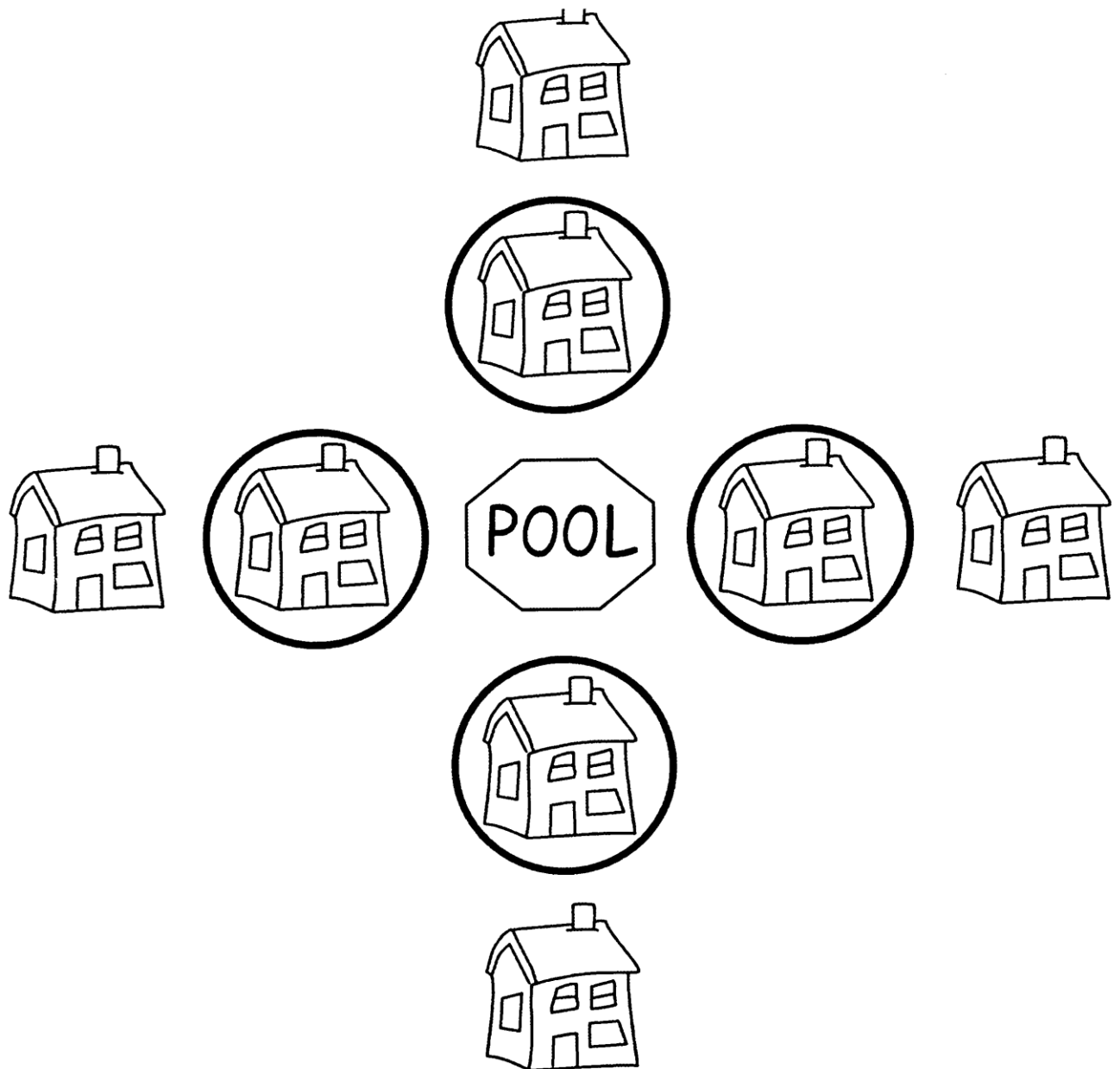

Fence Up!

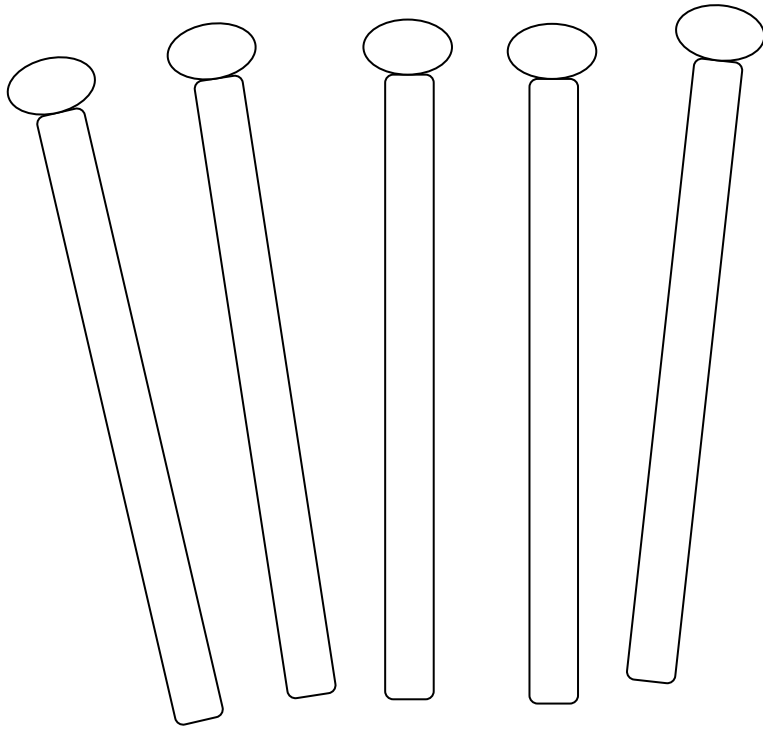


The circled homes show where young children live. Use fences so that the children in the circled homes cannot get to the pool, but people living in the other homes are able to.

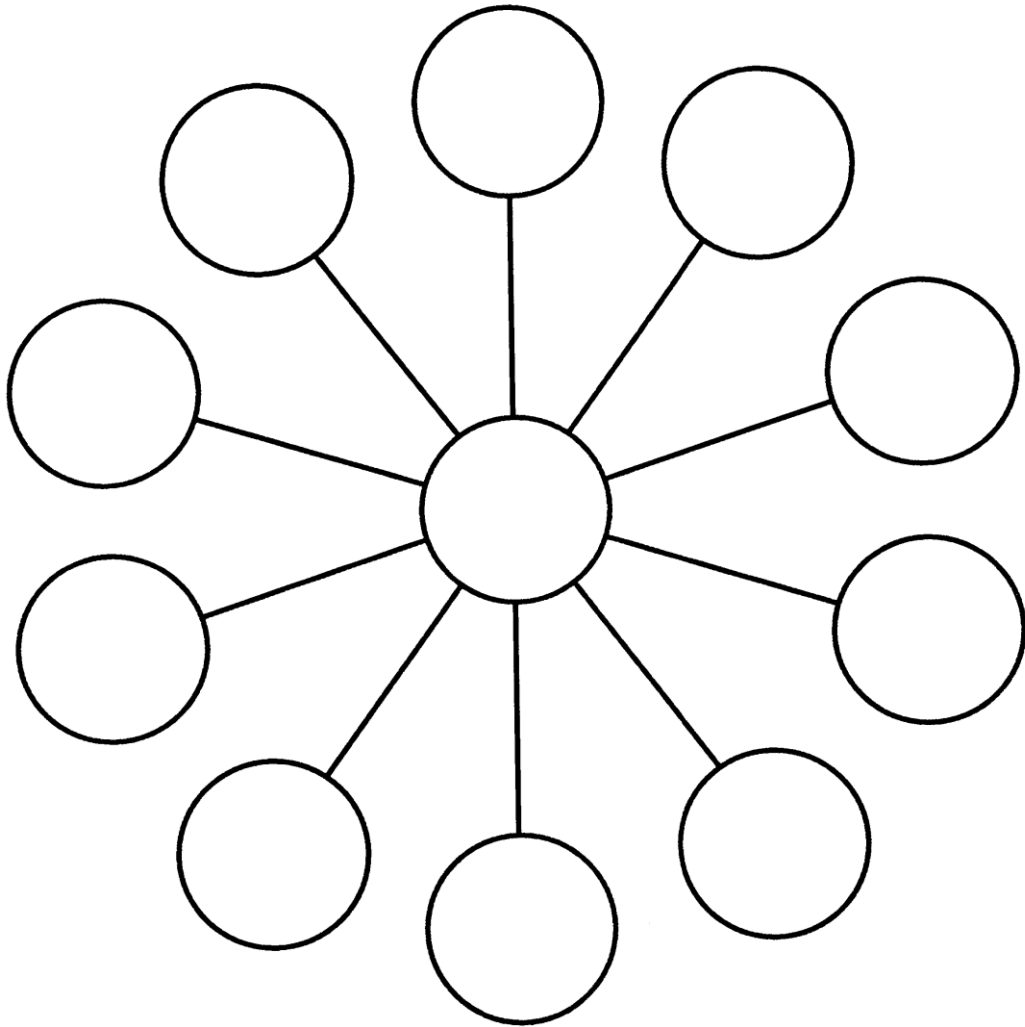

Place each of the numbers from 1 to 11 in a circle so that every straight line of 3 circles totals 18.

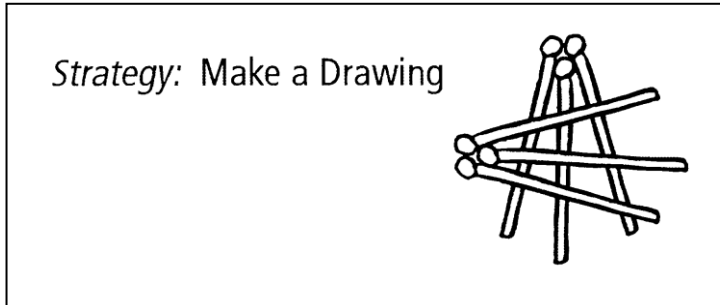
