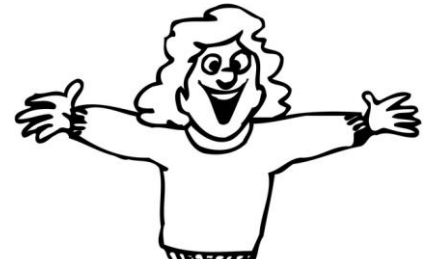

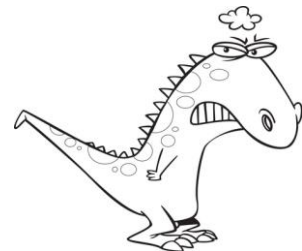

## Game Instructions:

Every set of cards consists of 3 words which are synonyms. For example, **cheerful**, **jovial**, **hearty** make one set.

**Objective:** Complete as many sets of cards as you can.

Number of players: 2-6

### Play Format 1

1. Cut up all the cards into individual pieces.
2. Choose the sets you would like to play with your child.  
2 players – minimum 4 sets  
3 players – minimum 6 sets  
4 players – minimum 8 sets  
5 players – minimum 10 sets  
6 players – use 12 sets
3. Shuffle all the cards. Each player randomly takes 3 cards.
4. Pile up the rest of the cards and let them face down.
5. Each player takes a turn to choose one card from the pile.
6. Now the player has 4 cards. Choose one to discard.
7. Put the discarded card on the table with the picture facing upwards.
8. The next player may either choose from the discarded cards or from the pile.
9. When a player manages to make complete sets with the cards on his/her hands, he/she may continue the game by choosing sets from the table top.
10. Game is to be played until all sets are completed.

### Play Format 2

Give out 2 groups of synonyms to the players, each with the same number of cards. Teacher/parent to keep one group of synonyms. As the teacher/parent put one word on the table, the other players must choose the corresponding 2 synonyms to put next to it. The winner is the player who is the first to rid all cards on his/her hand.
